## **SUPPLIES & STORAGE**

- Thursday & Friday, June 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> 9 AM to 6 PM. Transfer supplies from storage to the Festival site. Set up and organize the main supply room.
- Saturday June 14<sup>th</sup>, 7 AM to 9 PM & Sunday, June 15<sup>th</sup>, 8 AM to 6 PM and \* \*\* 6PM to 10 PM  
Supply room monitors. Sit down job.
- Monday & Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>, \*\*\* 10 AM to 5 PM. Organize and inventory remaining supplies and prepare them for return to the storage facility.

## **GRID & STENCIL**

- Wednesday, Thursday & Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup>, 9 AM to 4 PM Under the direction of experienced volunteers we will grid the streets and stencil the sponsors' names.

## **SETUP & TAKEDOWN**

- Friday, June 13<sup>th</sup>, 11 AM to 6 PM and Sunday, June 15<sup>th</sup> \*\*\* 6 PM to 10 PM Help with setting up booths and hanging signs. Volunteers with tool belts are much appreciated. Takedown on Sunday.

**BEVERAGE BOOTHS** 10 AM to 7 PM (Main Food Court, Bar Italiano and 4<sup>th</sup> Street Café) Adults only.

Wine, beer and soft drink sales. Some openings available - mostly staffed by returning volunteers. We always are in need of strong; able bodied volunteers who can help with moving cases of beverages and ice.

**FOOD COURT** 10AM to 8 PM. Students and adults. Prepare, wash, slice and serve food items.

**ICE CREAM CARTS** 10:30 AM to 6:30 PM on Saturday. 10:30 AM to 6:30 PM on Sunday, **4 hr. shifts.** Work in pairs selling ice Cream. Great job for parent & student or good friends.

**CHILDREN'S AVENUE** 9AM to 7 PM on Saturday and Sunday. Sell children's squares and soft drinks. Give out chalk, help the very young artists with their paintings and keep this Festival area clean and attractive for families. Student volunteers welcome.

**RAFFLE SALES** 11 AM to 3 PM and \*\*\* 3 PM to 7 PM on Saturday. 10 AM to 6 PM on Sunday. The great raffle prizes make this job easy. All you need is some energy and an outgoing personality.

**PRODUCT SALES** 10 AM to 7 PM. Sell merchandise on Children's Avenue and at the Youth in Arts Stores.

**PARKING MONITORS** 7 AM to 6 PM Saturday, 8 AM to 5 PM Sunday. **2 hr. shifts.** Monitor the gate at the B o A Garage, next to the Main Stage. Out of the sun. Great place to take a break from other jobs and hear the entertainment.

**BIKE VALET** 10 AM to 6 PM Saturday and Sunday. Assist Marin County Bike Coalition to safely accept and store bicycles.

**FESTIVAL RUNNERS** 9 AM to 7 PM. Keep the artists supplied with chalk and drinking water. Assist booth chairpersons with supplies and errands. This crew is constantly on the run!

**PHOTOGRAPHERS' ASSISTANTS** Noon to 7 PM on Saturday, 10 AM to 2 PM and \*\*\* 2 PM to 8 PM on Sunday. All of the artwork is photographed. Obtain signed media releases from the artists. \*\*\* Carry photo equipment and an aluminum ladder for the photographers. Help with crowd control. (Great way to see all the art and volunteer at the same time.)

**VOLUNTEER BOOTH** 8 AM to 5 PM. Help sign in volunteers as they arrive. Hand out T-shirts.

**CLEANUP AND BREAKDOWN CREW** \*\*\* 6 PM to 10 PM, Sunday only. Remove umbrellas and tablecloths, help fold tables and chairs. Gather and return equipment to supply room.
