## Assemblies

*Youth in Arts School Assembly prices are for one 45-minute performance or two back-to-back performances by the same artist.*

### North America

**African American Stories**—Stories of the African American experience, including classic tales and stories honoring African ancestors and contemporary heroes. (\$600/\$850)

**Mexican Folklorico**—Colorful traditional folk dances from regions of Mexico including Michoacan, Jalisco, Guerrero, Veracruz and Puebla. (\$725/\$900)

**Indigenous Traditions**—Stories and history of Native American peoples from the Plains to Central America presented through singing, dancing, or theater. (\$600/\$850)

**Juggling & Circus Arts**—A unique fusion of circus arts, body percussion, singing, juggling--some shows include mathematical origami tricks! (\$500/\$850)

**Haitian Music & Dance**—Colorful traditions of the Haitian people presented through music, dance and storytelling. (\$700/\$950)

**African Diaspora**—Music and dance based in Appalachian, West African, Afro-Cuban, Jazz and African-American spiritual traditions, blended with elements of “found sound” and Body Music. (\$1100-\$1200)

**Ecological Shows**— Environmental-themed performances focusing on conservation and global citizenship. (\$550/\$800)

**Multicultural Folktales**—Energetic, interactive storytelling from many lands. May incorporate ASL. (\$600/\$850)

**Songs of the American Civil War**— Inspirational marching songs, spirituals, slave songs and soldiers’ laments presented with stories of the time. (\$600/\$800)

**Til Dawn**—Award-winning teen *a cappella* company performs a mix of pop, rock, R&B, folk, gospel, and jazz. (\$600)

### South America

**Brazilian Folk Traditions**—Afro-Brazilian art forms ranging from capoeira (music, dance and martial arts) to Samba Reggae and Choro music. (\$725/\$950)

**Children’s Music from the Caribbean or Latin America**—Caribbean calypso or Spanish bilingual folksongs (\$500/\$725)

**Music of the Andes Mountains**—Melodies and rhythms from the high mountains festivities of Peru, Bolivia, Ecuador, Chile and Argentina. (\$725/\$900)

**Peruvian Dance and Music**—Traditional dance and instrumentation of the Afro-Peruvian culture of Peru’s coastal region. (\$600/\$950)

### Europe

**Medieval Music**—Medieval music from Europe with period instruments. Option to focus on songs from the region and era of Dracula! (\$725/\$1100)

**Mask Theater and Commedia dell’arte**—Masks, Pantomime, and Theatrical Clowning exploring the mysteries of mime illusions. (\$500/\$850)

**Neapolitano and Cabaret Music**—Musical styles from French Chanson, Italian and Neapolitan Canzone. (\$450/\$600)

### Africa

**West African Music & Dance**—Traditions of West Africa utilizing traditional instruments and costumes. (\$975/\$1150)

**South African Music & Dance**—Traditions of urban and rural South Africa, including gumboot dance and multilingual songs. Featuring performers from Zulu Spear and The Lion King. (\$500/\$840 or \$600/\$1200)

**Zimbabwean Music & Dance**—Traditional instrumentation and songs from Shona and other tribes of Zimbabwe. (\$850/\$1100)

### Asia/Pacific Islands

**Classical Indian Dance & Bhangra**—Traditional and contemporary forms of Indian dance and music. (\$850/\$1100)

**Classical Indian Music**—Explores the rich instrumentation and rhythms of the classical music of North India. (\$725/\$1100)

**Central Asia**—Dance, music and songs from one or more Central Asian traditions (Afghan, Tajiki, Uzbek, Azeri, Persian or Chinese-Turkman). (\$500/\$725)

**Dance and Folktales From Asia**—Interactive stories and dance from Japan, China, Indonesia and the Philipines. (\$700/\$850)

**Music and Dance of Hawai’i**—The rich and inspiring history of ancient Hawai’i through chanting, drumming and hula. (\$500/\$900)

**Australian Aboriginal Music & Culture**—Multimedia performance combining Djjeridu, history and art. (\$500/\$725)
